Karate Canada will be holding evaluations for coaches who are currently trained in Instruction Beginner and/or Competition Introduction. The evaluations will take place on Saturday January 14th and Sunday January 15th, 2017. Please find more information below:

Schedule and what to prepare

Saturday, January 14th, 2017 between 12:30pm-6:30pm

Sunday, January 15th, 2017 between 9:30am-12:30pm

Coaches will be given a 30-40m period between those times during which they will coach a karate practice involving a minimum of 2 athletes. Coaches need to come with their own athletes. The training should include all the key elements of a practice. Coaches will have a pre-brief and debrief on-site with the evaluator and should therefore plan to be there for a full hour.

Eligibility

To be eligible, coaches need to be trained in Instruction Beginner and/or Competition Introduction. The coach also needs to submit his portfolio to Karate Canada by January 6th, 2017. You can find the portfolio on our website. Coaches wanting to be evaluated also need to be members in good standing of their Provincial Karate Sport Organization recognized by Karate Canada.

Cost

The cost of the evaluation is \$220 and needs to be paid by January 6th, 2017. The coach can send a cheque to Karate Canada or pay by credit card via PayPal.
